All aboard!!! Welcome to Largo Central Railroad.

Thank you for your interest in joining the Largo Central Railroad (LCRR). We are a volunteer club within Largo Central Park. Largo Central Railroad, Inc. was founded and built in 1991 and is now maintained through the work and dedication of LCRR Club Members and through generous donations from the public. Our interest is in trains that operate on 7½ inch gauge track, and through our club and its activities, we share that interest with the public. As you may know LCRR provides rides to our guests during monthly Public Runs on the first full weekend (Saturday and Sunday) of every month. We also schedule on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays birthday runs at various times throughout the day. The third Saturday may be reserved for maintenance of the railroad and other work activities, or may also be scheduled for birthdays.

We currently have approximately 1.2 miles of mainline track with numerous passing sidings and crossovers running through beautifully landscaped Largo Central Park. As a prospective member you will learn how our railroad operates including building and maintenance of tracks, and of course becoming qualified for the train crew to name a few. There are many opportunities to learn all the different jobs that make the railroad run. As with anything the more you put in the more you get out and enjoy this wonderful hobby. Many of our members started out knowing very little of the operation.

Club membership meetings occur once a month immediately following the Saturday Public Run.

Also when there is a 5th Saturday we plan on a 'fun run' day. This is truly a play day for all of us, take out the trains and run, or participate in the activities that maybe planned like a poker run or switching contest and often a club provided lunch or dinner. We also have a Christmas Dinner in December that is our annual meeting as well, and then some members will decorate and run trains with the lights and participate in the parks light display that night (no public riders, only members)! And there is always a few other events during the year. As you can see there is always something going on.

Membership is open to anyone with interest in large scale model railroading and the hobby of live steam. There are different classes of membership;

- Regular Member
- Family Membership
- Associate Member [for person(s) living out of the area or who cannot actively participate]
- Junior Member (Must be sponsored by a LCRR member)


(Junior, Associate Members and persons under 18 under the Family Membership do not have voting privileges.)

If you are interested in membership, please read further through our documentation and complete the attached forms. Upon your submission you will be considered a "prospective member" under probation for the first 3 months. During that time we will train you in conducting and engineering and will monitor your activity and progress. Make sure you sign in and log your time on the Participation Log. Once your membership is approved and dues are paid – including name tag costs if any, your nametags will be ordered and you will receive your membership card and lapel pin.

WHAT LCRR EXPECTS OF YOU

Practice Safety and proper handling of equipment at all times. Participation and Involvement

Members are expected to get involved and actively participate in operation and maintenance of the railroad. Members are encouraged to participate in committees.

Members are expected to help on Public Run Days (*This ensures the continued use of the park property.*)

Members are expected to share and help to maintain the club property on scheduled workdays which is the third Saturday in the month.

No club equipment shall be removed from the club property without authorization of a club officer.

No member shall operate another member's engine or cars without the owner's permission.

All members shall sign the club register in the clubhouse each time they use the club property.

Children should be kept under control at all times.

Guests are not to be permitted on club property unless a member is present. It shall be the duty and responsibility of the last member to leave the club property on any given day to secure all equipment and buildings.

Membership Options

1) Regular Member (Individual)

Persons of good reputation having reached the age of eighteen years who have a serious interest in 7 ½ inch model railroading and who wish to actively participate on a regular basis shall be eligible for active membership. Active members will be afforded one vote at all elections and on all matters, which come before the membership during the course of a duly called meeting (monthly).

2) Associate Member

Persons who do not meet the requirements for active membership may qualify for associate membership. Associate members may attend meetings but shall not have a vote. Associate Members may not be elected or appointed to serve as Officers or Directors of the Largo Central Railroad, Inc.

3) Family Membership

Family membership is defined as husband, wife and any children under18. Each family member over the age of 18 will have full voting privileges. Children under 18 are to be accompanied by an adult while participating in club activities.

4) Junior Member

Persons under the age of 18 years who qualify for Junior Membership as listed below by being the children of members, a close relative of a member, or who are sponsored by a member may be appointed to Junior Membership in the Largo Central Railroad, Inc., provided the candidate meets the following qualifications and is approved by the Board of Directors:

- a) The Junior Member candidate has attended four or more club events where members have observed him/her and who have witnessed his/her qualifications as set forth herein and attest to them at the voting meeting.
- b) The candidate deports himself/herself in a respectable manner, creditable to his sponsor and the Largo Central Railroad, Inc.
- **c)** The candidate demonstrates respect for other people's property, is courteous and obedient, and will perform such work as he/she is directed to do which is within his/her capabilities when directed to do so by members.
- d) The parent or sponsor of the candidate pledges himself/herself, as attested to in the written application for Junior Membership, to be fully responsible and liable to pay for or repair any damage to a members, visitors or club's property whether damage was caused by accident or maliciously by said junior member.
- e) The candidate's sponsor must apply in writing to the Secretary of Largo Central Railroad, Inc., for admission of the candidate to Junior Membership and must include a statement to the effect that he accepts responsibility as set forth above for any property damage for which his candidate is found responsible.
- f) A Junior Member shall have the privilege of presenting himself/herself as a Junior Member, wearing any badge or insignia or of carrying a dues card of his office presented by the Largo Central Railroad, Inc. He/she will also have the privilege of attending open meetings. He/she shall receive instruction in the operation of club equipment and may operate after being qualified as determined by applicable By-Laws and certification by the Operations and Safety Committees.

Probation Period

Persons desiring membership in the Largo Central Railroad for regular or junior classes will be required to complete a three (3) month probation period. During this probation period the applicant will be monitored for participation and abilities during monthly scheduled run weekends and on normally scheduled work Saturdays. Upon completion of the probation the membership committee will recommend approval or disapproval to the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors will then submit the prospective member's application to the membership with their recommendation for approval or disapproval.

Member In Good Standing Status

Renewing members become members in good standing upon payment of the required annual dues and fees. New members become members in good standing upon completion of their probation period and payment of their required annual dues and fees. Membership in the corporation confers the right to hold office, to serve on committees, and to vote on matters concerning the operation and direction of the corporation.

Stop- Swung horizontally at right angle to the track.	1 short blast	Stopped- Apply brakes or wheel chocks.	Stop- Full stop before reaching the signal. Do not enter this block.
Proceed - Raised and lowered vertically.	2 short blasts	Start - Indicates the intention to start a standing train	Proceed - You are cleared to enter this block.
Back - Swung in a circle at right angle to the track.	3 short blasts	Back - Indicates the intention to back up a standing train	Caution - Be prepared to stop at next signal (slow down).
	2 longs, 1 short and 1 long (the final long being held until the train has entered the crossing)	Grade Crossing - Sound signal when approaching public crossings (roads, streets or walkways).	

Largo Central Railroad Safety Guidelines

In effect on Public Run days and for Birthday runs


- 1. All station and train crew duties are to be performed by members certified to carry out their respective jobs. The minimum operating crew shall consist of a Station Master, train Engineer, and Conductor.
- 2. All children under the age of 17 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 3. All trains must carry the following safety items:

Whistle or air horn or alternative means of immediate communication from Conductor to Engineer Fire extinguisher

Lights as needed

- 4. At no time is a running diesel or hot steam engine to be left unattended in a public area.
- 5. The public must be kept cleat of the Station platform while trains are pulling in or through the station area.
- 6. Safe loading of trains is of utmost importance. Cars must not be overloaded either in weight or in number of passengers and weight on cars must be balanced.
- 7. Each time the train stops at the station, the conductor is to inspect the couplers and safety chains and look for any other possible safety issues. The conductor may also assist the Station Master in loading the train.
- 8. Members who are not "on duty" in a particular job are to stay clear of the station platform so as not to be in the way of passenger loading or be a distraction to the crews on duty.
- 9. The pre-recorded safety message must be played before each train leaves the station. The message should be augmented by verbal reminders to passengers who may not have understood the rules.
- 10. In the event the pre-recorded safety message is unavailable, the Station Master must verbally review the safety rules to each set of passengers.
- 11. On Public Runs, all trains are to obey speed restrictions. The limit is 5MPH on main line track, and slower speeds over the pond, through the tunnel, through the station, and in areas the track is being serviced.
- 12. No extra gasoline is to be carried on trains with the public. Refueling of diesel engines is to be done with the engine shut off, on the refueling siding or in the yard.

Largo Central Railroad, Inc. Member/Applicant Disclosure Form

In order to be considered, an applicant is required to complete this disclosure. If the applicant is under the age of eighteen, the applicant's parent or guardian must complete the form on behalf of the applicant. Any falsifications, misrepresentations, or incompleteness in this disclosure alone is grounds for disqualification or termination, wherever said falsifications, misrepresentations, or incompleteness is discovered.

By signing this form, I am certifying that I have not been found guilty or entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendre (no contest), regardless of the adjudication, to any of the following charges under the provisions of the Florida Statutes or under any similar statute of another jurisdiction. I also certify that I do not have a delinquency record that is similar to any of these offenses.

I understand I must acknowledge the existence of any criminal records relating to the following list regardless of whether or not those records have been sealed or expunged. I understand that I am obligated to notify the Largo Central Railroad, Inc. of any possible disqualifying offenses that may occur while a member of the Largo Central Railroad, Inc. If you have been found guilty or entered a plea of guilty or nolo contender, you may not work in any position involving the public unless you apply for and are granted an exemption from the Florida Department of Children and Families.
